

Indicator Rubric Template

Each working group will focus on a particular domain and evaluation question. Using this worksheet, create a five-level rubric that demonstrates five different degrees of achievement of a given indicator.

The first steps are to write the evaluation question and the basic indicator statement. Then, create a statement which shows a degree of achievement. Many evaluators find it easier to **start from the highest degree of achievement and work backwards** when creating their rubrics.

With each degree of achievement, describe the data your evaluation process will accumulate to support the contention that you have **or have not** attained a particular degree of achievement.
